From the Columbus, OH, Airport

As you leave the airport, get onto I-270 South toward the I-70 interchange. You will travel approximately 10 miles on I-270. As you approach the I-70 interchange, I-270 splits into two sets of lanes. It does not matter which set you take, but the left set has less merging traffic, so is usually a bit faster. If you take the right set, stay to the left, so that you don't get forced onto I-70.

Immediately after the I-70 interchange, the two sets of lanes re-merge. Once that has settled out, change lanes toward the right, so that you will be positioned to take US-33 East, Exit 46 B (the **second** off-ramp at the I-270/US-33 interchange). You will travel on US-33E for approximately 67 miles from I-270 to get to Athens.

Fourteen miles from I-270 you will reach the exit for Business US-33 through the city of Lancaster. Business US-33 encounters numerous traffic lights, but provides access to motels, gasoline filling stations, and restaurants. The Lancaster bypass is now open, and unless you need those services, we do advise that you use the bypass, staying on US-33 instead of taking the Business Route exit as you approach Lancaster. Continue on US-33 East past Logan and through Nelsonville.

After Nelsonville, as you approach Athens, **pass the first OH-682 exit** (for "The Plains"). If there is a stop sign at the end of the OH-682 off-ramp, you have taken the exit for The Plains. You can either turn right, go to the fourth traffic light and turn left onto Richland Avenue, or get back on the highway and follow the directions in the next paragraph.

After US-33 E joins US-50 W and OH-32 W in Athens, take Exit 17, for OH-682 N. Turn right at the first traffic light, onto Richland Avenue, to cross the Hocking River and enter the Ohio University campus. You will be at coordinates E-6 on the <u>campus map</u>, with the Convocation Center on your left and Peden Stadium on your right.

From Southwest Ohio

If you are driving from Southwest Ohio, take OH-32 E to Athens. If you are driving from the Chillicothe area, take US-50 E to Athens.

Just West of Albany, OH, at the Ohio University Airport, OH-32 E and US-50 E join together. Continue East on OH-32 and US-50. Pass the exit for US-33 E to Pomeroy, OH (that off-ramp exits to the left). Take Exit 17, for OH-682 N. You will have gone about nine miles from the airport. Turn right at the first traffic light, onto Richland Avenue, to cross the Hocking River and enter the Ohio University campus. You will be at coordinates E-6 on the campus map, with the Convocation Center on your left and Peden Stadium on your right.

Location & Directions (continued)

From Wood County Airport in West Virginia

If you are flying into the Wood County Airport in Parkersburg, WV, take WV-2 South approximately 3 miles to I-77 South, approximately 4 miles, to US-50 West.

Stay on US-50 W through Parkersburg and Belpre, OH. The four-lane bypass for US-50 through Parkersburg, WV, and Belpre, OH, has been completed, using a new bridge over the Ohio River. Stay on US-50 W (which joins OH-7 W and OH-32 W for parts of your travel) from Belpre to Athens. Once you cross the Ohio River, you have about 45 minutes still to go.


Stay on US-50 W all the way up the Hocking River valley to the city of Athens. This will require an **exit** from the OH-7 four-lane less than a mile West of the small sign to turn left for "downtown Coolville."

US-50 is now four lanes all the way from Belpre to Athens.

After US-33 E joins US-50 W in Athens, take Exit 17, for OH-682 N. Turn right at the first traffic light, onto Richland Avenue, to cross the Hocking River and enter the Ohio University campus. You will be at coordinates E-6 on the <u>campus map</u>, with the Convocation Center on your left and Peden Stadium on your right.





Athletics Mall - Center

Meet Entries

Entry Deadline: Entries must be submitted electronically via email to the Meet Director. All swimmers must be members of USA swimming.

All entries are due by Wednesday, May 4, 2011 at 5:00 pm (Eastern Time).

All entries must be submitted on Hy-Tek. There will be a \$20 fee for teams with five or more swimmers who do not use Hy-Tek.

Entry Fees: Entry fees for this meet will be \$4.00 for Individual Events and \$7.00 for Relays. In addition there will be a \$2.00 fee for each swimmer for the Ohio travel fee. (example 4 Individual, 1 Relay would be \$25.00)

Payment: All fees will be collected through the Aquatic Center. Checks should be made payable to Campus Recreation. The Aquatic Center also will accept American Express, Visa and Master Card.

Deck Entries: Deck entries will only be accepted if space is available in a heat. Additional heats will not be added for Deck Entries. Deck entry fees will be \$5.00 for individuals and \$8.00 for relays.

Entry Limit: Swimmers are allowed to swim a Maximum of five (5) events per day, plus relays. Please note that any Time Trials count toward the five (5) event total.

Positive Check-In: Check-In will be required 30 minutes prior to the beginning of each session for all events 400 meters or longer. **Entry into these events will be limited to the fastest 40 swimmers.**

Limits: Events 400 Meters in length shall be limited to the forty (40) fastest swimmers. Events 800 meters or longer shall be limited to the twenty four (24) fastest swimmers.

Time Standards: THERE WILL BE NO TIME STANDARDS USED FOR MEET ENTRIES.

Entry Verification: All Entries will be submitted back to coaches for verification.

All Entry Verifications are due by Sunday, May 8, 2011 at 5:00 pm (Eastern Time).

Swimmers with a Disability are Welcome to Enter Ohio Swimming Meets:

- 1) Provide advance notice of any necessary accommodations;
- 2) List in the email with the Hy-Tek entry (or on paper) the swimmer's name, entry times, stokes/distances, days/sessions, and how the swimmer prefers to be seeded. More info is available under Adaptive Swimming on the OSI website.

Rules

USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will govern the conduct of this meet and will serve as the official guide for technical and procedural rules.

Awards: All age groups will be given awards 1st thru 3rd. Team awards will be given. No awards will be given for Time Trials.

Scoring: Scoring will be done within each age group, 8 and under, 9-10, 11-12. 13 and Over session will not be scored. No scoring for Time Trials.
